- The TESOL Endorsement Program consists of a total of 24 quarter credit hours. Each course is five weeks in length; the field experience portion of the practicum may vary in length depending on the nature of individual student's field experiences. Courses are offered consecutively online.
- Tuition is at the Professional Development student rate of 50% full tuition. The Professional Development rate for Academic Year 2008-2009 is currently \$206 per credit hour.
- LTCY 780P is a pre-requisite to LTCY 782P; LTCY 782P is a pre-requisite to LTCY 784P; all three are pre-requisite to LTCY 786P.
- A maximum of 9 quarter credit hours (6 semester credit hours) may be transferred to the UC TESL Program from another university. Courses must be comparable in content and credit hours.
